The United States Probation Office for the Southern District of Georgia intends to procure treatment services for federal defendants and persons under supervision using Blanket Purchase Agreements (BPA) and for one Non-Competitive Purchase Agreement. Blanket Purchase Agreements are for the period beginning October 1, 2026, through September 30, 2027, with a provision for the Government to unilaterally extend the agreement in accordance with Section I, Clause 2-90D, Option to Extend the Term, for an additional four years, at four twelve-month intervals. Required services for the BPAs include but are not limited to case management; assessments/evaluations; counseling in the areas of co-occurring disorders, mental health, sex offense; and polygraph examinations. The one Non-Competitive Purchase Agreement is for the period beginning October 1, 2026, through September 30, 2027. The required services for this purchase agreement are case management; assessments/evaluations; counseling in the areas of co-occurring disorders, and mental health.
